

### **Directions to Forth Wetherill, Jamestown, R.I.**

From Hartford, take Route 2 east to exit 28 north (I-395 north)

Take exit 85 off I-395 and follow Route 138 east (go straight about a half mile).

Take a right, staying on Route 138 east.

Continue straight as it turns into Route 165 east into Rhode Island (about 12.5 miles).

Take a left onto Route 3 north and go about one mile to Route 102.

Take a right on Route 102 south and go about eight miles to Route 4 south which will be a hard right hand turn on to the Route 4 ramp. This road turns into Route 1 south as you bear to the right.

Take the exit for "Jamestown and Newport Bridges. Just before the bridge, bear to the right and take the Jamestown exit. Proceeding over the Newport Bridge is a mistake.

Follow this road along first the golf course to your right then the water on the left. Proceed through the first stop sign (stop first).

Go about one and-a-half miles till you see the entrance for Fort Wetherill State Park on the left. Bear left into the park.

Enter the park and take your first right, immediately turn left and continue straight. The parking lot will be ahead of you on the right.

If the van has not arrived, please save us a good spot somewhere near a grassy area. Please be prompt for your dive briefings.

### **When Returning Home**

Note: after going over the Jamestown Bridge west bound, take the exit labeled Route 1 NORTH, towards Providence. As you get off the ramp, stay to the extreme left to get on Route 4 north. Ensure you take the exit for Route 102 north.
